

Rules and Regulations

Rules are necessary to preserve the park's appearance and to prevent any major mishaps. Please make your visit safe and enjoyable by following posted rules and regulations.

- In case of emergency, or to contact a park ranger dial 911
- Park in designated parking lots only.
- Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.
- The park is closed from dusk to dawn. The front gate is open at 8:00 A.M.
- Visitors must clean up after their pets.
- Wildlife and plant life shall be left undisturbed.
- Additional information is posted on the bulletin boards.

Directions to the Park

From Rt. 30 follow N. Sherman Street north, 2.2 miles to traffic light crossing North Sherman Street. Go 1 mile, turn left on Rt. 24. Turn left on Maudie Lane Rd. Park on right.

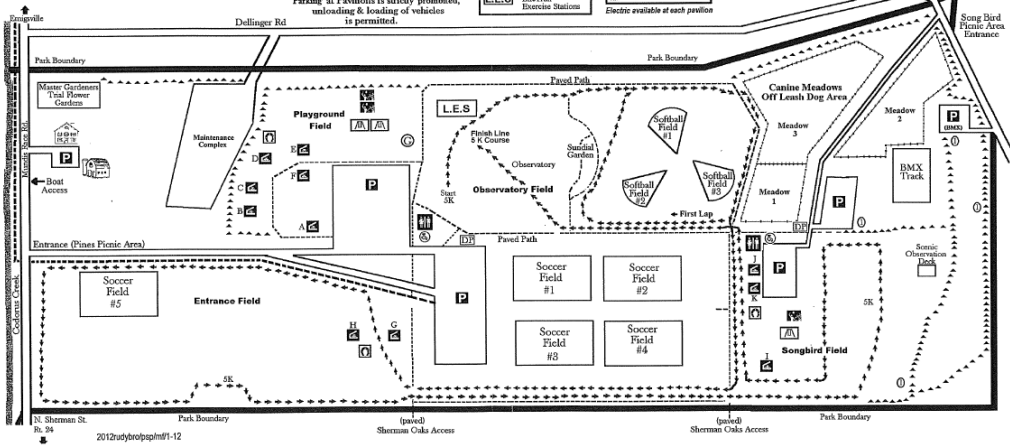
